- Admission shall be subject to the outcome of Writ Petition (Civil) No. 600/2015 pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

Selection of the candidates belonging to FN/NRI/NRI Sponsored category will be made strictly as per general merit list of CLAT 2023.

- **Application fee** of Rs. 5000/- has to be remitted via Paytm portal.

Incomplete application will be summarily rejected and the University shall not entertain any claim in this regard.
