VASUDHAIVA KUTUMBAKAM KI OAR 3.0

The transitioning world order brings with it a trove of opportunities for the betterment of humanity. Because actions that are taken now will shape the world for centuries to come, leaders must make responsible decisions. To discuss and deliberate on the issues of the present world order and the potential of the new one, **Jyot** (a not-for-profit and apolitical NGO) organised two conclaves titled **'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam ki Oar'** in 2022 and 2023. The first edition, with the theme **'Arya Niti and World Order'**, delved into the history of how the present world order came into being. The second edition, with the theme **'Future of Western World and Global South'**, was more forward looking and considered what opportunities the new world order may bring.

Both conclaves received positive responses and success, the second surpassing the first. Organised under the aegis of **Spiritual Sovereign His Holiness Jainacharya Yugbhushansuriji**, they were aimed at creating a platform to discuss the wisdom contained in ancient scriptures and reviving the tradition of encouraging dialogue between political, military and economic leadership with spiritual leadership. The 2023 conclave had a fruitful conclusion in terms of a joint declaration called **'Manilaxmi Tirth Declaration'** that was signed by the partner organisations, namely, **Jyot, Vivekananda International Foundation, India Foundation and Gitarth Ganga.**

After the conclave, Jyot began an outreach program to propagate the outcome to diplomats and consulates from different countries in India. Jyot has met with officials from 23 embassies so far, and its mission is continuing. Its literature also reached the UNGA president, as acknowledged by the Indian mission at the UN.






His Holiness, **Spiritual Sovereign Jainacharya Yugbhushansuri Maharaja**, one of the 79th descendants of Tirthankar Shri Mahavir Swami, has been gracing the land of India since his renunciation in 1979.

His Holiness is a scholar not just in Jain Darshan but in all six Darshans originating in India. He has always remained informed about contemporary affairs in multiple disciplines, including biology, physics, economics, and politics and their interplay with the principles of spirituality. He is an expert in delivering religious sermons in the context of modern ideas to depict the versatility of religious principles.

Having kept track of the global political order, he had perceived that the genesis of all the threats to Indian religions is situated in the current world order. For this, he researched the trajectory of the world order in depth by hiring top legal firms like Cyril Amarchand Mangaldas and AZB & Partners along with the involvement of several litigation counsels. One of the focus areas of his research was to understand the de-jure world order starting from the Roman conquest of England to the decolonisation of Hong Kong.

Since his intent for the research was to recognise threats and take action to protect religions, he has never published his research or findings. He has occasionally indicated

SOVEREIGNTY, BASIC STRUCTURE DOCTRINE AND SECULARISM

This year, considering the significance of the legal domain of governance, Jyot, with pleasure and the permission of His Holiness, has decided to organise a legal conclave as part of the 'Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam ki Oar' conclave series in its third edition. This initiative aims to discuss the fundamental legal issues that are central and basic touching not just the law points but also the jurisprudence of the laws of the land. With this, the panellists would strive to discover the ideal ideas and beliefs that go into forming jurisprudence and ultimately lead to making laws compatible with land, people, their culture and their civilisation. To set an environment of true civil liberty through such high level discussions forms part of our aim.

The inaugural theme, 'Sovereignty, Basic Structure Doctrine, and Secularism', will focus on key questions relevant to contemporary times, exploring both national and international jurisprudence. The panel will critically and objectively evaluate current legal frameworks, emphasising that laws and jurisprudence must reflect the traditions, beliefs, and cultures of the people they serve. Success will be measured by how well these frameworks preserve the core values of civilisation while adapting to its evolving needs.

This year marks a unique convergence of three landmark milestones in India's constitutional history. India is in the 75th year of its Constitution, which is said to establish its sovereignty as an independent republic. It marked the 51st year of the Basic Structure Doctrine, laid down in the historic Kesavananda Bharati case, a principle that delineated the scope of the State's power to amend its foundational principles. Additionally, this year marked the 30th anniversary of the S. R. Bommai judgement, which recognised secularism as a key element of the Basic Structure of the Constitution. Each of these milestones represents a vast field of jurisprudence.

Additionally, this year marks the **2550th year after the Nirvana of Tirthankar Shri Mahavir Swami,** signifying a profound convergence of constitutional and spiritual milestones. This gathering of legal luminaries, scholars and thought leaders will be graced by the **79th successor of Tirthankar Shri Mahavir Swami, His Holiness Shri Yugbhushansuriji.** Together, they will analyse these concepts through a constitutional lens, thereby offering new perspectives regarding their interpretation and application in the current landscape and blending legal and spiritual wisdom.

















GLOBAL TRUST, MULTIPOLARITY AND THE ROLE OF VISHWABANDHU BHARAT

The theme of 'Global trust, multipolarity and the role of Vishwabandhu Bharat' continues the exploration of a new, free, fair, and just world order. With a focus on implementing ideas from previous conclaves, this edition addresses the challenge of declining global trust and its impact on shaping a multipolar world. It also highlights the key role Bharat (India) can play as Vishwabandhu, in this evolving order.

The third conclave will deliberate on these aspects in the context of the central theme of Vasudhaiva Kutumbakam. We will discover how the timeless knowledge of Indian scriptures and traditions decoded by spiritual leaders has insights for the present and future of the world order, especially when navigating challenges.

This conclave will be guided by **His Holiness Spiritual Sovereign Jainacharya Yugbhushansuriji.** His expansive analysis of geopolitics, economics, foreign policy and other subjects in tandem with spirituality will provide a unique perspective to the discussions. In most conversations about geopolitics and world events, the spiritual aspect is lost. **However, if the new world order is to be made in a way that benefits all equally, the spiritual dimension must be reintroduced.** His Holiness's profound insights will be key.

Organised over two sessions, the conclave will welcome experts and leaders from various fields to debate the topic at hand. The morning session will be closed-door, and the evening session will be open to all. Both sessions can be expected to have diverse perspectives and engaging dialogue. The panellists will answer different questions posed to them.

In 2013, the 'Knowledge About Knowledge' exhibition was presented in Bengaluru. It was attended by more than 5 lac people.


In Bengaluru, a digital version of the entire exhibition titled 'Journey to Enlightenment' was released.


